A wet spell is likely affect Gilgit-Baltistan in current week. During this period, scattered rain, thunderstorms, and isolated heavy falls, are expected in Gilgit-Baltistan. The prevailing weather conditions, increase the risk of Glacial Lake Outburst Floods (GLOFs), flash floods, and landslide events in vulnerable glaciated regions of Gilgit-Baltistan.
