A wet spell is likely to affect Gilgit-Baltistan and Khyber Pakhtunkhwa in the current week. During this period, scattered rain and thunderstorms, with isolated heavy falls, are expected in Gilgit-Baltistan and Khyber Pakhtunkhwa. The prevailing weather conditions, increase the risk of Glacial Lake Outburst Floods (GLOFs), flash flood, and landslide events in vulnerable glaciated regions of Gilgit-Baltistan and Khyber Pakhtunkhwa.
