Due to persistent higher than normal temperatures and expected rain spells from 6th to 8th July in Gilgit-Baltistan (GB) and upper parts of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa (KPK), there is an increased likelihood of triggering GLOF events, flash floods, landslides, and a rise in river stream flows due to melting. Warmer conditions are expected to persist until the mid-July. The district administration, concerned line departments, and local communities are advised to remain vigilant and observe precautionary measures in vulnerable areas.
