## **GLOF ALERT**

Dated: 2<sup>nd</sup> October, 2025 Issue Time: 03:00 PM

A significant wet spell is expected to impact Khyber Pakhtunkhwa (2-7 October, 2025) and Gilgit-Baltistan (4-7 October, 2025). These conditions may trigger Glacial Lake Outburst Floods (GLOFs) in vulnerable glaciated regions, along with the risk of flash floods in local streams and nullahs and landslides in hilly areas. Local communities are advised to remain vigilant, while concerned authorities are requested to take precautionary measures to safeguard lives and infrastructure.

2. All concerned are advised to remain vigilant and ensure necessary precautionary measures to mitigate the risk of any adverse situation.
