Over the past few days, temperatures over the northern mountainous regions remained above normal. In addition, the expected widespread weather spell from 10th to 12th March in the whole Gilgit Baltistan (GB) and upper Khyber Pakhtunkhwa (KPK) there is an increased risk of Glacial Lake Outburst Flood (GLOF), Flash floods, and landslide in these areas and the surrounding regions, particularly near glacier terminus. Local communities are advised to remain vigilant, while concerned authorities are requested to take precautionary measures to safeguard lives and infrastructure.

2. All concerned are advised to remain alert and take necessary measures to avoid any untoward situation.
