## **GLOF ALERT**

Dated: 22<sup>nd</sup> August 2025 Issue Time: 03:00 PM

In continuation to the GLOF alert issued dated 18<sup>th</sup> August 2025, the wet spell is likely to prevail from 23<sup>rd</sup> August 2025 and can affect Gilgit-Baltistan and Khyber Pakhtunkhwa. During this period, scattered rain and thunderstorms, with isolated heavy falls, are expected in Gilgit-Baltistan, and Khyber Pakhtunkhwa. The prevailing weather conditions, increase the risk of Glacial Lake Outburst Floods (GLOFs), flash floods, and landslide events in vulnerable glaciated regions of Gilgit-Baltistan and Khyber Pakhtunkhwa.

2. All concerned are advised to remain alert and take necessary measures to avoid any untoward situation.
