In continuation of the GLOF Alert issued on 27th August 2025, the hydro-meteorological data from the stations installed at Arkari, Badswat, Darkut, Hisper Hoper, Ghundus and Gulkin under GLOF-II Project indicates a significant rise in temperature values, much higher than normal, which may accelerate glaciers melt. There is an increased probability of GLOF and flash floods in the aforementioned locations in particularly, and in other areas generally.

 All concerned are advised to remain vigilant and take necessary precautionary measures to avoid any untoward situation.
